PROLOG 3th JEWISH CULTURE FESTIVAL Fire

June 26th – December 18th, 2020

PROGRAM REPORT



The jubilee, 30th edition of the Jewish Culture Festival, planned to be held in summer 2020, had to be postponed to 2021 on account of the coronavirus pandemic.

Yet, we did not want to give up our plans nor to leave our audience alone, without the Jewish Culture Festival. We thought that since our friends and fans of the JCF cannot come to Kazimierz, it is our turn to drop by. This time with online events

We decided to start exactly when the 30^{th} Jewish Culture Festival was supposed to start. i.e. on June 26^{th} , 2020 and to end on December 18^{th} – the last day of the Hanukkah. The Festival of Lights was for us an ideal symbolic closure of the Prolog to the 30^{th} JCF, which we dedicate to the Fire.

Prolog 30th JCF is the longest Jewish Culture Festival ever – lasting 6 months!

We created a hybrid festival formula, which connected free events held online with live performances and events – both with the audience and without it. It contained all the events which usually made up the Festival: concerts, DJ parties, lectures, debates, guided tours, workshops, Literary Program and the classes within the Workshops for Seniors – these all reached out audience via our Internet channels: www website, Facebook profile and YouTube channel.

But we also created new events – a series of podcasts available on our Spotify profile, YouTube and on www website, the playlists of our friends who co-created the JCF together with us, or the recommendations of the contemporary Israeli books. We also changed the formula of our newsletters, which now have become not only the reports about our activity, but also presented a number of unique texts created especially for our newsletters by our Festival Friends.

Prolog events reached **1,229,778** worldwide! We are grateful to our audience for inviting us so often to their houses with the Prolog 30th JCF. We have lit a fire which will burn with its full power in 2021, during the jubilee,30th edition of the Jewish Culture Festival in Krakow's Kazimierz.

Out of **80** events only two could be organized with audience's presence: (concert by Bastarda and a lecture by Janusz Makuch) – all the others were held only online, including four concerts that were played live and streamed live, however without audience... **47** events were commissioned for **Prolog 30th JCF.** We invited **146** artists, lecturers and instructors from **5** countries: Poland, Israel, , Germany, United States and Turkey.

PROLOG 30th JCF | PROMOTION

PROLOG 30th JCF | SCOPE AND REACH

Below data concern the period of duration of the Prolog 30th JCF: June 26th – December 18th, 2020

During the Prolog the information about this event was present in 656 media (mentions, references, articles). They reached 302,669 persons, with the advertising value equivalent (AVE) of 827,380 PLN (according to the analysis of Brand24).

Prolog events, held in the internet were viewed by 1,229,778 persons worldwide – all together on all internet channels of the festival, where they were either streamed live or rebroadcast (detailed information below). Now they are still available there and the number of viewers is still growing.

Among our internet audience we have **52% of women and 48% - men**. Almost one quarter of them are between 35 and 44 years old. Here is more detailed breakdown:
