Let us meet with a group of people for whom civic values and human rights are very important.

In Poland over the last few years we have been witnesses to unequal treatment of participants of strikes and protests, demanding IDs from protesters by the police, chicanery of the human rights activist, and discrimination of women. Excluding minorities led to Poland being listed last twice on the ILGA-Europe list, which ranks EU member countries according to protection of LGBTI rights, in 2020 and 2021.

Join us and find out how to build an open, diverse, and equal society, as well as how to react to discrimination.

Zuzanna Rudzińska-Bluszcz is a lawyer. In 2015-2021 she was the chief coordinator of strategic court proceedings in the Ombudsman Office of the Republic of Poland. She was the independent candidate for Polish Ombudsman, supported by numerous non-governmental organizations. Since 2021 she has been the head of the ClientEarth Workers for Earth Foundation.
